MEMORANDUM AND ORDER DENYING MOTIONS FOR LEAVE TO FILE REPLIES IN DISQUALIFICATION MATTER

Intervenors, Union of Concerned Scientists (UCS) and Three Mile Island Alert (TMIA) have each filed motions for leave to reply and have proffered replies to responses in this disqualification matter. Both motions are denied.

UCS's effort¹ is an untimely supplement to its disqualification motion. As noted in the memorandum and order denying the disqualification motions (February 20, 1985), UCS's pleading contains significant factual errors concerning its allegation that I have formed judgments based on extrajudicial information. The pleading is not helpful.

TMIA's proposed reply² has two purposes within my jurisdiction.

The first (II A) responds to Licensee's argument that TMIA's motion to disqualify is untimely. That aspect of the tendered reply is moot, because I disregarded Licensee's valid complaint about the timeliness of TMIA disqualification motion. The other portion of TMIA's tendered reply (II B) is a supplement to its initial disqualification motion. It contains nothing of substance which could not have been advanced initially. The motion to reply is denied as untimely on that account.
