Subject: WEAPONS MISUSE

Region I received telephone notification on February 20, 1985 that a contract security officer's employment had been terminated for his involvement in an incident. The incident took place on February 17 and involved "horse play" between two security officers on duty inside the plant. One officer withdrew his weapon from the holster during the incident, an automatic dismissal offense; the other officer did not draw his weapon. The incident was reported on February 18 by one of the officers involved and the other admitted his involvement when questioned. No weapon was discharged and no one was injured. The second officer involved received a reprimand and was retrained in the proper use of handguns. All armed security officers were cautioned regarding their duties and responsibilities in the use and handling of weapons.
