OYSTER CREEK - REACTOR STARTUP FOLLOWING REPUELING

I called Walt Paulson, the Oyster Creek RL Project Manager, on Friday, May 9, 1975 to inform him that the current startup schedule for Oyster Creek was now May 15. Wait was interested in time dependent work in progress at the reactor. Paulson stated that he planned to contact GPU to inform them that RL had completed the ECCS evaluation and therefore, had no objection to Shutdown Margin Testing. I informed Walt that our posture was unchanged with respect to "Startup" definition. This information was acknowledged by Paulson. OIE:HQ was apprised of the Oyster Creek status (Dreher) and based on this call, RL (Paulson) was recontacted. Mr. Brunner and Mr. Caphton participated in this conversation. Paulson was asked if the RL Review Status was such that RL was in a position to issue memorandum which could be internal, denoting that startup and operation up to some power levels such as 75% was acceptable, until necessary Tech Spec changes concerning the reload were completed by RL. Paulson stated that he would pursue this avenue on Monday, May 12, 1975 and further that GPU would not be contacted on May 9, 1975.
