I received a call from Ivan Finrock on Friday, January 11, at 1:20 PM.

Mr. Finrock was about ready to enter the Court House to answer the Writ of Injunction from the State of New Jersey.

Mr. Finrock indicated that his position was that they want to come down tonight based on primarily the following significant factors:

1. ~~Aside from~~ the 120 day inspection limit on the seismic system experience.
2. The increased identified leak rate.
3. They have to come down to 40% power to test ~~some~~ <sup>stem</sup> main isolation valves.

Mr. Finrock said that he would keep me or my staff informed on the moment-to-moment crises at Jersey Central. I asked him about the Public Information problem. He stated that he would give this a lot of attention and thought it would be smart if they updated their previous release and issued something as soon as they could and it certainly would not be before he left the Court House. He told me that he would let me know ~~and we expected his people to be dealing with ours.~~
