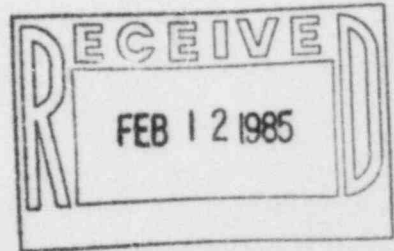

Gentlemen:

This letter documents agreements made between members of your staff and PSC during a meeting in Bethesda on January 31, 1985. Based upon those agreements, PSC will submit Report No. 4 to our 10CFR50, Appendix R Fire Protection Evaluation per a schedule revised from that in the referenced letter. The scope of Report No. 4 will include NRC comments from the January 31, 1985 meeting. Additionally, a Report No. 5 will be submitted to expand the scope of the evaluation to include items not originally included in the subject evaluation.

The schedule for these two reports and the major scope revisions mutually agreed to are as follows:



Report No. 4	April 1, 1985	<p>Evaluation of whether liner cooling must be maintained in conjunction with Forced Circulation. If yes, include liner cooling in Forced Circulation Shutdown Model.</p> <p>Sufficient design details for proposed modifications for NRC staff to concur with justification/exemption request.</p> <p>Request for scheduler exemptions from Section 50.48 of 10CFR50. This request shall include any recommended interim actions to be performed during completion of various permanent actions.</p>
Report No. 5	June 1, 1985	Review of Building 10 to Branch Technical Position APCBS 9.5-1, Appendix A
