CHANGES

- LCO 4.6.1            1.) Deleted.
- LCO 4.6.1.1        1.) Describes minimum electrical system requirements for power operation.
- LCO 4.6.1.2        1.) Describes minimum electrical system requirements for low power, shutdown and reference conditions.
- 
- SR 5.6.1            1.) Clarified normal starting conditions and start signal.
- 2.) Deleted requirement to check the day tank for accumulated water after a run of 2 hours or more.
- 3.) Increased minimum load time from 60 to 90 seconds.
- 4.) Added requirement for the water-jacket heaters on the diesel engines to be operable.
- 5.) Expanded Table 5.6.1-1 to be more similar to the Standard Technical Specification (STS).
- 6.) Added Table 5.6.1-2 on diesel generator reliability for completeness.
- 7.) Described the diesel engine protective functions in detail.
- 
- SR 5.6.2.            1.) Deleted requirement on battery charger supplying the name plate rating for eight hours.
- 2.) Changed "partial discharge test"... to "service discharge test"...
- 3.) Added requirement to run performance discharge tests once per 60 months, including acceptance criteria.
- 4.) Adjusted rows in TABLE 5.6.2-1 to make it more easily read.
