CONTAMINATED SHIPMENT FROM OYSTER CREEK (OC)

I received a telephone report at 1:30 P.M. on 8/22/75 from Terry Womstrand of NYS, West Valley, New York.

At 0445 8/22/75, a shipping cask was received from JCP&L Co (OC) at NYS which was contaminated greater than the 22,000 dpm DOT limit.

Six of 38 smears taken on the cask exceeded the limit. The highest was 56,000 dpm.

There was nothing unusual about the shipment - the cask was dry, etc.

Ed Greenman, Project Inspector for OC was informed.
