CONTAMINATED SHIPMENT FROM OYSTER CREEK (OC)

I received a telephone report at 1:30 P.M. on 8/22/75 from Terry Wesstrand of MFS, West Valley, New York.

At 0445 8/22/75, a chipping cask was received from JCP&L Co (OC) at NFS which was contaminated greater than the 22,000 dpm DOT limit.

Six of 38 smears taken on the eask exceeded the limit. The highest was 56,000 dpm.

There was nothing unusual about the shipment - the cask was dry, etc.
