

River Bend Station - Unit 1 Refer to: RIV Docket No. 50-458/I&E Bulletin 83-07

In a letter dated May 30, 1984, Gulf States Utilities Company (GSU) responded to Bulletin 83-07 "Apparently Fraudulent Products Sold by Ray Miller, Inc." with the information available at that time and committed to provide a final response or status report by September 28, 1984.

GSU's investigation has determined that no defective material or equipment manufactured by Ray Miller, Inc. has been procured for use at River Bend Station in safety-related systems by its vendors (the architect/engineer, Stone & Webster Engineering Corporation and NSSS supplier, the General Electric Company) or through their subsuppliers as identified in I&E Bulletin 83-07 and Supplements 1 & 2.

GSU is continuing its investigation to determine if any defective material or equipment has been procured for use at River Bend Station in nonsafety-related systems. GSU anticipates completion of its investigation by November 26, 1984. At that time GSU will provide a final response or a status report.
