



River Bend Station - Unit 1 Refer to: RIV Docket No. 50-458/I&E Bulletin 83-08

In a letter dated March 29, 1984, Gulf States Utilities (GSU) responded to Bulletin 83-08 "Electrical Circuit Breakers with an Undervoltage Trip Feature in Use in Safety-Related Application other than the Reactor Trip Systems" with information available at that time and committed to provide a final response or status report by September 28, 1984.

In the March letter, GSU stated that the investigation revealed no General Electric Type AK circuit breakers with the undervoltage trip attachment or Westinghouse DB-50 trip breakers had been included in the River Bend Station design in safety-related applications.

GSU has determined that no circuit breakers with an undervoltage trip feature have been provided for use in safety-related applications at River Bend Station within its architect/engineer (Stone & Webster Engineering Corporation) scope of supply. GSU is working with its NSSS supplier (General Electric Company) to identify circuit breakers (other than DB 50 or AK) with the undervoltage trip feature. GSU anticipates that the investigation will be completed by November 30, 1984. At that time GSU will provide a final response or a status report.
