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

Dear Mr. Keppler:

In our last letter to you dated December 21, 1983, concerning the Suppression Pool Corrosion Monitoring System (SPCMS), we stated it was our intent to have the full Monitoring System for Unit I in place and functional by November 1, 1984. This installation was based upon a December 1984 fuel load.

Since the fuel load date is now scheduled for June 1985, there has been a delay in the tie-in of the SPCMS to the Emergency Response Information System (ERIS). However, work on the Suppression Pool Corrosion Monitoring System continues. To date, design is completed, monitoring hardware is installed, and cable runs are being completed in preparation for the computer tie-in.

Full implementation of the SPCMS is now scheduled for March 22, 1985.
