

SUBJECT: OYSTER CREEK NUCLEAR GENERATING STATION
DOCKET NUMBER 50-219
ECCS PERFORMANCE

Our letter dated July 3, 1975 presented a sensitivity analysis of ECCS performance based on the results of our June 24, 1975 submittal in compliance with licensing conditions required in Oyster Creek Provisional Operating License Amendment No. 8. In order to accommodate the results of the July 3, 1975 analysis, the Oyster Creek Technical Specification MAPLHGR limits were conservatively reduced by 2.0% and we indicated that we would provide you with a schedule for submission of revised MAPLHGR Technical Specifications by July 15, 1975.

This is to inform you that we have been working with General Electric Company to formulate this schedule and have not concluded our negotiations as yet. We expect to arrive at a satisfactory schedule shortly and will contact you as soon as a firm schedule is established. In the interim, Oyster Creek will continue to operate in accordance with the conservative reduction in MAPLHGR's indicated in our July 3, 1975 letter.
