Electric Cooperative, Inc. (Susquehanna Steam Electric Station, Units 1 and 2), LBP-81-8, 13 NRC 335, 337 (1981).

Contrary to Applicant's presentation, it is evident from Sunflower's material facts that Ashtabula County Medical Center does not possess the physical facilities nor the trained personnel to handle a major radiation release accident at Perry. Dr. Robert McTrusty, M.D., acting Ashtabula County Medical Center's Disaster Planning Liaison Physician, has rendered an affidavit depicting some of the shortfalls he sees at his facility.

For all of the reasons attested, summary disposition should be denied.
