Gentlemen:

By letter dated September 10, 1975, you informed us of an unusual event regarding the Oyster Creek Nuclear Generation Station reactor building to torus vacuum breaker valves V-26-16 and V-26-18 which were found not wired to close on a high drywell pressure signal, contrary to the design criteria stated in the Facility Description and Safety Analysis Report. Your letter stated that the following corrective actions will be accomplished to correct this deficiency:

- (1) Initiate design changes to accomplish closure of V-26-16 and V-26-18 on high drywell pressure.
- (2) Provide interim administrative controls to assure closure of V-26-16 and V-26-18 when required.

To enable us to complete our evaluation of this unusual event, we request that you provide us with the date that the plant modifications will be completed and the details of the interim administrative controls that have been instituted. We request that you provide this additional information by October 21, 1975.
