Subject: Request for Additional Information Re Use of Staff Pipe Clamps in the Perry Nuclear Power Plant (Units 1 and 2)

The NRC staff has reviewed your response to a question related to the use of stiff pipe clamps in the Perry piping system (Q210.15), submitted by your letter dated October 1, 1984, and finds your response to be incomplete.

Item 4 of your response to Q210.15 states that discussions with E-Systems, Inc. determined that, since many of the specified torque values can be significantly reduced without compromising the load rating, it was not considered necessary to implement special requirements for post-installation/operational verification of those clamps. If the torque values, whether high or low, are required for the functional adequacy of the applicable support, it is requested that your staff provide a further technical justification for not performing post-installation/operational verifications. Specifically, it is requested that the impact of lower pre-load torque values on the required stiffness of the support (as assumed in the piping stress analysis) be addressed in detail. Your response should be provided as an amendment to Q210.15 for eventual documentation in the FSAR.

Please advise the Perry Project Manager when we may expect to receive your response within 5 days after receipt of this letter.
