Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. Hyson of this office on March 25-27, 1975 and April 8-10, 1975 at the Oyster Creek Nuclear Generating Station of activities authorized by NRC License No. DPR-16 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Hyson with Mr. Carroll and other member of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during this inspection are described in the Office of Inspection and Enforcement Inspection Report which is enclosed with this letter. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Based on the results of this inspection, it appears that certain of your activities were not conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements, as set forth in the Notice of Violation, enclosed herewith as Appendix A. These items of noncompliance have been categorized into the levels as described in our correspondence to you dated December 31, 1974. This notice is sent to you pursuant to the provisions of Section 2.201 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice", Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations. Although Section 2.201 requires you to submit to this office, within 20 days of your receipt of this notice, a written statement of explanation, we note that these items of noncompliance were corrected prior to the completion of our inspection and therefore, no response with respect to these matters is required.

Certain other activities appear to be deviations from appropriate codes, standards, or guides, as set forth in the Notice of Deviation, enclosed herewith as Appendix B. With respect to these deviations, please include in your response your comments concerning these items, a description of any steps that have been or will be taken to correct them, a description of any steps that have been or will be taken to prevent recurrence, and the date all corrective actions or preventive measures are or will be completed.
