Dear Mr. Daltroff:

It has been brought to our attention that security guards monitoring the site exit portal monitors may have instructed workers, who have alarmed the portal monitors, to walk through the monitors a second time, but more quickly, so the monitors would not alarm. A second concern brought to our attention involves the possible loss of an increasing number of dosimeters by the security guards.

We request that you review Security's role in the control of portal monitors and your dosimetry program requirements. We also request that you evaluate Security's control of dosimeters and any trends involving increasing numbers of dosimeters being lost. Please provide your evaluation to this office, in writing, within thirty (30) days.

Because these concerns are the latest of two recent radiation protection program concerns brought to our attention, we further request a meeting to discuss our own concerns in relation to your radiation protection program. We will contact you to discuss a mutually acceptable date and time.

Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
