MEMORANDUM (Request for Sanctions)

We understand the facts on filing deadlines to be essentially those set by the Staff in its "Response to Case's Motion for Sanctions Due to Pepeated Untimely Filings by Applicant," October 31, 1984. Although we do not believe that Applicants' delays are adequately excused by the circumstances, we will not now impose sanctions on the attorneys involved. They should be aware that time deadlines are serious commitments that they are expected to meet and that excuses are to be the rare exception to that general rule.

As a result of Applicants' tardiness, CASE is entitled to recompense. We agree with the Staff that CASE should have a reasonable opportunity to supplement its liner plate allegations. It may do so by November 14, 1984. However, this should <u>not</u> be understood to be a firm deadline. If CASE requires more time, it should request it. CASE has kept its time commitments and we therefore trust its judgment as to whether more time may be required.
