The copies of LEA's filing of off-site emergency planning testimony on admitted contentions made on November 2, 1984 which were hand delivered to the Board, the NRC Staff and Mr. Troy Conner, Counsel for the Applicant did not contain the enclosed request for a subpoena to obtain the testimony of Mr. John Waters, Emergency Manager and Fire Marshall for Lower Merion Township, Montgomery County, in relation to contention LEA-24. This item was included in the list submitted with LEA's testimony on the bottom under the heading, 'subpoenas requested for LEA-24'. All other copies of the filing did include the enclosed Motion to the Board.
