RULINGS IN RESPONSE TO THE PARTIES JOINT REPORT ON HEARING ON OFFSITE EMERGENCY PLANNING

Cn November 1, 1984, the Applicant filed a Joint Report on behalf of the parties in the hearings scheduled to begin on November 19, 1984. The Joint Report conveys to the Board the results of an October 30, 1984 meeting the parties held to discuss procedural matters relating to the upcoming hearings. Some of the matters discussed call for rulings from the Board. These rulings appear below.

1. The Board approves the parties' agreement that the hearings should begin with LEA's contentions. Hearings on the City's issues will begin on December 3, 1984, or as soon thereafter as completion of the hearings on LEA's contentions permits.

2. The Board approves the orders of presentation the parties agreed on at the meetings. Thus, for LEA's contention the order is:

Applicant, LEA, Commonwealth, and NRC/FEMA. The order for the City's issues is: Applicant, Commonwealth, City, and NRC/FEMA.

3. Rather than burden this hearing record with all the county, municipal and school district plans, the Board will assign exhibit numbers to the plans for purposes of identification, and then in the course of the hearings, a party may move to have relevant parts of the plans admitted into evidence.

4. The Board will not accept written rebuttal testimony filed before the hearings.
