Oral argument on the intervenors' challenge to the Licensing Board's October 16, 1984 supplemental initial decision¹ will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, November 29, 1984, in the NRC Public Hearing Room, Fifth Floor, East-West Towers Building, 4350 East-West Highway, Bethesda, Maryland. 
first and may reserve a reasonable portion of their time for rebuttal.
