Thank you for informing us of the corrective and preventive actions documented in your letter for the violations cited in Appendix A of our letter. These actions will be examined during a future inspection of your licensed program.

Regarding your response to the violation cited in Appendix B of our letter, based on a September 7, 1984 telephone discussion between Mr. T. Ellsroth of your staff and Mr. W. Madden of this office, we understand that you have conducted further review of the circumstances surrounding this violation. The results of your review indicated that the information provided in our inspection report (No. 84-13) is factual and in agreement with your current understanding. Therefore, this violation will remain as cited. Also, based on this telephone discussion, it is our understanding that all appropriate security personnel will be reinstructed in procedural requirements affecting the search features of your access control program, including monitoring and alarm response, by October 8, 1984.

If the above is not in accordance with your understanding, please notify this office within 30 days after receipt of this letter.

In accordance with 10 CFR 73.21 of the NRC's regulations, documentation of security measures for the physical protection of special nuclear materials and certain plant equipment vital to safety of production, or utilization facilities is deemed to be Safeguards Information. Each person who produces, receives or acquires Safeguards Information is required to ensure that it is protected against unauthorized disclosure. Therefore, Attachment B to your letter will not be placed in the Public Document Room and will receive limited distribution pursuant to 10 CFR 73.21(c).


