Except for the verification of the operating crew qualifications, the changes to Chapter 13 of the FSAR, contained in Amendments 14 and 15, are considered to be in compliance with the acceptance criteria cited in the Standard Review Plan (NUREG-0800), and are therefore acceptable, to the staff. The operating crew qualifications will be held as an open item in the next Perry SER supplement (No. 6) unless this information is acceptably documented in a FSAR amendment, as indicated by your staff, prior to issuance of SER Supplement No. 6.
