Dear Mr. Belair:

This is in further response to your letter dated December 21, 1984, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), copies of documents related to the issues discussed in the May 16, 1984, Commission order (CLI-84-8) in the Shoreham proceeding.

The documents listed on enclosed Appendix B are being placed in the NRC Public Document Room (PDR), located at 1717 H Street, NW, Washington, DC 20555, in folder FOIA-84-942 in your name.

The transcripts identified on enclosed Appendix C are being withheld in their entirety. The closed Commission meeting transcripts have been reviewed, and it has been determined that they are exempt in their entirety from mandatory public disclosure under Exemption (10) of the Government in the Sunshine Act. The discussion during this meeting specifically concerned the NRC's conduct in a particular case of formal agency adjudication. Accordingly, the transcripts are being withheld in their entirety pursuant to Exemption (10) of the Government in the Sunshine Act (5 U.S.C. 552b (c)(10)) and 10 CFR 9.104(a)(10) of the Commission's regulations. The person responsible for the denial of the transcripts is Mr. John C. Hoyle, Assistant Secretary of the Commission.

This denial may be appealed to the Commission within 30 days from the receipt of this letter. Any such appeal must be in writing, addressed to the Secretary of the Commission, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, DC 20555, and should clearly state on the envelope and in the letter that it is an "Appeal from an Initial FOIA Decision."

The search for and review of documents related to your request is continuing. As soon as the search and review are completed, we will notify you.
