ORDER

Oral argument on the appeals of Palmetto Alliance and Carolina Environmental Study Group from the Licensing Board's three partial initial decisions<sup>1</sup> will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, April 3, 1985, in the NRC Public Hearing Room, Fifth Floor, East-West Towers Building, 4350 East-West Highway, Bethesda, Maryland. Each side is allotted a total of forty-five minutes for the presentation of argument.<sup>2</sup> The appellants will be heard first and may reserve a reasonable portion of their time for rebuttal.
