Subject: Inspection No. 50-219/84-23

This refers to the routine safeguards inspection conducted by Mr. Jack M. Dunlap of this office on August 6-10, 1984 of activities authorized by NRC License No. DPR-16 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Dunlap with yourself at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during this inspection are described in the NRC Region I Inspection Report which is enclosed with this letter. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Our inspector also verified the steps you have taken to correct the deviation brought to your attention in a letter dated October 25, 1983. We have no further questions regarding your action at this time.

Based on the results of this inspection, it appears that certain of your activities were not conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements, as set forth in the Notice of Violation, enclosed herewith as Appendix A. These violations have been categorized by severity level in accordance with the revised NRC Enforcement Policy (10 CFR 2, Appendix C) published in the Federal Register Notice (49 FR 8583) dated March 8, 1984. You are required to respond to this letter and in preparing your response, you should follow the instructions in Appendix A.

Sections of the enclosed inspection report contain details of your security program that have been determined to be exempt from public disclosure in accordance with either 10 CFR 73.21 (Safeguards Information) or 10 CFR 9.5.(a)(4) (Commercial or Financial Information). Therefore, the sections so identified in the inspection report and Appendix A, containing Safeguards Information, will not be placed in the NRC Public Document Room and will receive limited distribution. The inspection report cover sheet and any remaining portions of the inspection report will be placed in the Public Document Room, in accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), unless you notify, by telephone, the Supervisor, Files, Mail and Records, USNRC Region I, at (215) 337-5223, within 10 days of the date of this letter and submit written application to withhold information contained in the report within thirty days of the date of this letter. Such application must be consistent with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.790(b)(1).

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The responses directed by this letter and the accompanying Notice are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.

Your cooperation with us in this matter is appreciated.


