ESTABLISHMENT OF ATOMIC SAFETY AND LICENSING BOARD
TO PRESIDE IN PROCEEDING

Pursuant to delegation by the Commission dated December 29, 1972, published in the Federal Register, 37 F.R. 28710 (1972) and Sections 2.105, 2.700, 2.702, 2.714, 2.714a, 2.717 and 2.721 of the Commission's Regulations, all as amended, a new Atomic Safety and Licensing Board is being established in the following proceeding to preside over the remand proceeding involving the October 29, 1984 initial decision issued by the previous Licensing Board* which granted Long Island Lighting Company's March 20, 1984 "Supplemental Motion for Low Power Operating License" (LBP-84-45, 20 NRC 1343). On February 21, 1985, the Atomic Safety and Licensing Appeal Board remanded the case to the Licensing Board for further proceedings. ALAB-800, 21 NRC ____ (February 21, 1985).


