1.a.) Question: Has any B&W plant in the U.S. ever completely replaced the entire steam generator(s)?

Reply: No.

b.) Question: Has any B&W plant in the U.S. ever disassembled the steam generator(s) and replaced specific parts?

Reply: Yes. See 1.c. below

c.) Question: Which parts and when?

Reply: Yes. Although no major disassembly (e.g., retubing) has been performed on any B&W steam generator, such items as feedwater inlets and tube plugs have been modified or replaced. These modifications have taken place over a period of years.

2.) Question: If completely replaced, what were the actual hardware and labor costs for replacing the entire steam generators(s) at a B&W plant in the U.S.?

Reply: See 1.a. above

3. Question: If any B&W steam generator(s) in the U.S. has never been completely replaced, what is the estimated cost of total replacement at Three Mile Island Unit 1?

Reply: Replacement costs of steam generators have been estimated at between \$150 and \$450 million, depending on plant-specific design, extent of replacement (retubing vs. complete replacement), and replacement scheduling and technique. These figures include replacement power cost for the period the plant is shut down. The NRC staff has made no estimate for TMI-1 specifically and is not aware of the result of any such estimate which may have been made by others.
