Dear Ms. Varricchio:

This is in further response to Mr. Clewett's letter dated August 7, 1984, in which he requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), copies of all agency records relevant to and/or generated in connection with either of two specified incidents at the Callaway nuclear plant.

Document 16 of enclosed Appendix A (continued) as well as the released portions of Documents B1, B2, and B3 of Appendix B are being placed in the NRC Public Document Room, 1717 H Street NW, Washington, DC 20555, where they will be available for public inspection and copying.

Documents B1, B2, and B3 of enclosed Appendix B contain unclassified safeguards information. The statutory authority for withholding this information is found in Section 147 of the Atomic Energy Act (42 U.S.C. 2167). This information is being withheld from public disclosure pursuant to exemption (3) of the FOIA (5 U.S.C. 552(b)(3)) and 10 CFR 9.5(a)(3) of the Commission's regulations.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 9.9 of the Commission's regulations, it has been determined that the information withheld is exempt from production or disclosure, and that its production or disclosure is contrary to the public interest. The persons responsible for this denial are the undersigned and Mr. James G. Keppler, Regional Administrator, Region III (Chicago).


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This denial may be appealed to the Commission's Executive Director for Operations within 30 days from the receipt of this letter. As provided in 10 CFR 9.11, any such appeal must be in writing, addressed to the Executive Director for Operations, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, DC 20555, and should clearly state on the envelope and in the letter that it is an "Appeal from an Initial FOIA Decision."
