Inspection Summary

Inspection on October 16-19, 1984 (Report No. 50-461/84-34(DRSS))

Areas Inspected: Included a review of the licensee's actions in planning, scheduling, and implementation of the security program. The inspection involved 26 inspector-hours by one NRC inspector.

Results: The licensee appeared to have progressed excellently in planning and scheduling for implementation of the security program. Construction activities for security functions appeared to be progressing adequately. The licensee's basic security plan, which also includes the Training and Qualification Plan and Safeguards Contingency Plan required review and possible submittal of a plan revision to HQ, NRC. Additionally, several major elements of the security program needed to be included in a formal implementation schedule to assure that site senior management personnel could monitor implementation progress.
