Dear Mr. Keppler:

Our final report to you dated April 24, 1984, concerning a potential deficiency associated with heat treating of "type AN" piston skirt castings stated that two spare "type AN" pistons identified at PNPP as being potentially defective would be returned to the manufacturer. Transamerica Delaval was to inspect, stress relieve if necessary, and return the pistons; or replace them with new, properly heat treated pistons. Corrective action was anticipated to be complete by October 1984.

At this time, the two spare "type AN" pistons have been returned to Transamerica Delaval; however, due to the results of the TDI Owners Group recommendations for this component, they have been dispositioned as "scrap" and will be replaced by properly heat treated "type AE" pistons.

Corrective action will be accomplished upon receipt of "type AE" pistons for use as spares and is anticipated by December 21, 1984.
