P R O C E E D I N G S

2 CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: Please come to order.

3 This is an affirmation/discussion session. We have
4 one item scheduled on the agenda. I understand there is a
5 second item that is proposed for addition to the agenda. I
6 am going to ask the Secretary to walk us through both items.

7 MR. CHILK: The first one, Mr. Chairman, is
8 SECY-85-18. It is a motion for a stay of low power authori-
9 zation and a suspension of low power license.

10 The Commission in this paper is being asked to
11 respond to a notice by the Limerick Ecology Action to stay
12 the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board decision that authorizes
13 the issuance of a low power license for Limerick.

14 The motion also asks for suspension of Limerick's
15 low power license.

16 The votes on the matter are that the Chairman,
17 yourself, Commissioners Roberts, Bernthal, and Zech have
18 approved an order denying that motion. Commissioner Asselstine
19 did not participate in this action.

20 Would you please affirm your votes?

21 CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: Aye.

22 COMMISSIONER ROBERTS: Aye.

23 COMMISSIONER ZECH: Aye.

24 MR. CHILK: The second item is an affirmation of a
25 request for stay in Shoreham, and before I ask for a vote, I

1 would have to ask the Commission to vote to hold this on less
2 than one week's notice. If I could have such a vote.

3 CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: Aye.

4 COMMISSIONER ROBERTS: Aye.

5 COMMISSIONER ZECH: Aye.

6 MR. CHILK: Thank you.

7 The Commission here is being asked to respond to
8 a request from the State of New York and Suffolk County to
9 stay its February 12 authorization for a low power operation
10 for Shoreham or, in the alternative, to extend the administrative
11 stay granted in the Commission's February 12 ruling.

12 The Chairman, Commissioner Roberts, Commissioners
13 Bernthal, and Zech have indicated their approval of an order
14 denying the request for a stay. Commissioner Asselstine would
15 have granted the stay.

16 With regard to the request for extension of the
17 effective date of the Commission's order, the Chairman and
18 Commissioners Asselstine, Bernthal, and Zech have approved
19 the extension until 5 p.m. on February 25, 1985. Commissioner
20 Roberts voted to deny the request. A copy of the order was
21 attached to our dissemination of February 14 to you. Would
22 you please affirm those votes?

23 CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: Aye.

24 COMMISSIONER ROBERTS: Aye.

25 COMMISSIONER ZECH: Aye.

1 MR. CHILK: Thank you.

2 CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: Anything more to come before us?

3 MR. CHILK: I have nothing.

4 CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: Thank you. We'll stand
5 adjourned.
