CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: Please come to order.

This is an affirmation/discussion session. We have one item scheduled on the agenda. I understand there is a se ond item that is proposed for addition to the agenda. I am going to ask the Secretary to walk us through both items.

MR. CHILK: The first one, Mr. Chairman, is SECY-85-18. It is a motion for a stay of low power authorization and a suspension of low power license.

The Commission in this paper is being asked to respond to a notice by the Limerick Ecology Action to stay the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board decision that authorizes the issuance of a low power license for Limerick.

The mostion also asks for suspension of Limerick's low power license.

The votes on the matter are that the Chairman, yourself, Commissioners Roberts, Bernthal, and Zech have approved an order denying that motion. Commissioner Asselstine did not participate in this action.

Bernthal, and Zech have indicated their approval of an order

denying the request for a stay. Commissioner Asselstine would

have granted the stay.

With regard to the request for extension of the effective date of the Commission's order, the Chairman and Commissioners Asselstine, Bernthal, and Zech have approved the extension until 5 p.m. on February 25, 1985. Commissioner Roberts voted to deny the request. A copy of the order was attached to our dissemination of February 14 to you. Would you please affirm those votes?

CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: Aye.

COMMISSIONER ROBERTS: Aye.

COMMISSIONER ZECH: Aye.

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MR. CHILK: Thank you.
