The above references concern the issue of failure to maintain interpass temperatures on stainless steel socket welds which was examined as an allegation by A. Herdt's Branch with my assistance. Reference 1 is the Management Meeting letter which was sent to the licensee and the PDR. As a result of the meeting, it was understood that DPC would begin their inquiry into the matter based upon the presentation of information made by the staff at the management meeting on March 13, 1984.
