This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Messrs. A. L. Madison, A. D. Morrongiello, J. C. Bjorgen, and C. D. Anderson of this office on September 6 through October 6, 1984, of activities at Quad Cities Nuclear Power Station, Units 1 and 2, authorized by NRC Operating Licenses No. DPR-29 and No. DPR-30, and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. N. J. Kalivianakis at the conclusion of the inspection.

The enclosed copy of our inspection report identifies areas examined during the inspection. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, and interviews with personnel.
