



The Commission met to receive oral arguments by the parties to the Shoreham licensing proceeding on the initial decision of the Shoreham Licensing Board, which was issued on October 29, 1984 and which granted an exemption to Long Island Lighting Company (LILCO) from the requirements of 10 CFR 50, Appendix A, General Design Criterion 17 during Phases III and IV of low power testing. The purpose of the meeting was to receive arguments by the parties prior to the completion of the Commission's review of the October 29, 1984 order.
