Dear Mr. Mendes:

This is in regard to the August 22, 1984, telephone conversation between you and Dr. Jerry Harbour, Ms. Linda Robinson, and Ms. Nina Toms of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission concerning the referenced Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request.

During that conversation, Dr. Harbour informed you of circumstances concerning the two matters raised in Mr. Eissler's letter dated July 18, 1982. In addition, Dr. Harbour discussed some of his pertinent activities as project manager for research under the U. S. Geological Survey (USGS)/ Atomic Energy Commission (AEC) Interagency Agreement for 1969 through 1973. As agreed, we are enclosing copies of program statements and work plans related to that agreement from among Dr. Harbour's personal files. Dr. Harbour noted that while the enclosed records may not contain any information in regard to the specific subjects on which your organization requested records originally, the records may be of help to you in understanding the nature of reporting utilized and identify reports which are germane to your general interest in Diablo Canyon. Following Dr. Harbour's explanatory remarks, Ms. Robinson identified a particular report prepared and published by USGS through funding assistance from AEC, USGS Open File Report No. 74-352, and informed you of the address of the USGS Publications Center in Denver, Colorado, where you may obtain a copy of the report.

We hope that you find the information provided to you during the conversation and the records we are enclosing of benefit. As noted during the conversation, you may submit another FOIA request for any additional specific agency records in which you may be interested.

This request is filed under the Freedom of Information Act as amended (5 U.S.C. Section 552).

We seek copies of the following:

All documents prepared by and made available to the NRC and AEC and their staffs between October 1, 1972 and September 1, 1973 on the offshore fault at Diablo Canyon (identified as the Hosgri Fault), including minutes of meetings, records of discussions, telephone conversations, memorandums, and correspondence.

If you determine that some or all of the documents are exempt from release, we would appreciate being notified which exemption(s) you believe covers the materials you are not releasing. We are prepared, if necessary, to execute an appropriate protective agreement with respect to any confidential or proprietary document. Finally, if you determine that some portions of the requested record are exempt, we ask that you make available the remainder of the record.

We request that the records requested be sent to us directly. In the event you determine the quantity of these documents are so large as not to permit forwarding them, we request that they be made available for inspection at the Washington, D.C. office.


Assuming that you are unable to mail the records to us directly and once the records are made available for review, we will determine whether we want any of the records reproduced.

We believe this request is in the public interest as a public benefit and, therefore, any applicable fees should be waived as permitted under the Freedom of Information Act as amended.
