Dear Mr. Felton,

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act enacted in 1967 and amended in 1974,  
I am requesting copies of the following documents:

1. Letter dated September 24, 1984 from Mr. Neal E. Abrahams, NRC attorney to Mr. Ray, attorney for Phoenix Power which disavows any breach of law or regulations by the NRC in their dealings with Phoenix Power and affirms that any information transmitted verbally or in writing by Phoenix Power to the NRC was done so without mention of a trade mark or proprietary considerations.
2. Letter dated September 24, 1984 from Phoenix Power to Neal Abrahams, NRC attorney which summarizes Phoenix Power's impressions of a joint meeting on September 21, 1984.
3. NRC minutes from the September 21, 1984 meeting with Phoenix Power and minutes from any previous meetings with Phoenix Power.
4. Minutes from the NRC meeting (Rockville Research Branch) with Phoenix Power to be held on November 1, 1984.

This information is germane to members of the nuclear industry who have independently developed symptom based EALs related to fission product barriers and who are now being intimidated by Phoenix Power. These tactics not only hinder utilities who wish to pursue a symptom based approach advocated by the NRC but also the joint Brookhaven/industry effort to develop a viable option to the current Appendix 1,


