SUBJECT: REPORT NO. 50-302/84-21

On June 27 - July 30, 1984, NRC inspected activities authorized by NRC License No. DPR-72 for your Crystal River facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed inspection report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress.

The inspection findings indicate that certain activities violated NRC requirements. The violation, references to pertinent requirements, and elements to be included in your response are presented in the enclosed Notice of Violation.

The violation described in the enclosed Notice is similar to violations contained in Notices of Violations sent to you with our letters dated December 28, 1983 (83-29), February 7, 1984 (84-02 Item 1), April 19, 1984 (84-09, Item 2), and June 27, 1984 (84-16). These violations also dealt with failures to follow procedures. Since "similar violations" as described in the NRC Enforcement Policy are of significant concern to the NRC, we have separately requested an enforcement meeting to discuss the actions you intend to take to prevent recurrence of procedural type deficiencies.

Your attention is invited to unresolved items identified in the inspection report. These matters will be pursued during future inspections.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter, its enclosures, and your reply will be placed in NRC's Public Document Room upon completion of our evaluation of the reply. If you wish to withhold information contained therein, please notify this office by telephone and include a written application to withhold information in your response. Such application must be consistent with the requirements of 2.790(b)(1).

The responses directed by this letter and the enclosures are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget issued under the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.
