II. Shoreham -- Immediate Effectiveness Review of October 29,
1984 Licensing Board Order Authorizing Grant of Exemption
from GDC-17 for Phases III and IV of Low Power Testing
(SECY-85-38/38A)

The Commission, by a 4-1 vote, approved an order that allows the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Order of October 29, 1984 to become effective. Commissioner Asselstine disagreed and had separate views. Chairman Palladino and Commissioners Roberts, Bernthal and Zech provided additional views.
