Dear Mr. Sholly:

This is in further response to your letter dated April 30, 1984, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), a copy of the following document:

NUREG/CR-3301 - "A Catalog of PRA Dominant Accident Sequence Information," by N. G. Cathy, et al., EG&G - 2259, EG&G Idaho, Inc., June 1983

By letter dated June 5, 1984, we released those portions of the requested document which pertain to 11 plants and denied that portion (Appendix M) which pertains to the Limerick plant. At this time, we are placing Appendix M pages M-1 through M-29 in their entirety (List of Tables in Appendix M) and portions of pages M-30 through M-63 (Table M-1.0) in the NRC Public Document Room in file folder FOIA-84-329.

The General Electric Company (GE) maintains that release of the deleted information on Table M-1.0 (pages M-64 through M-141) and all of the information on Tables M-2.1 through M-5.4 (pages M-30 through M-63) could cause substantial harm to the competitive position of GE. Among other things, the analyses were developed with the expenditure of substantial GE resources and public availability of the information would deprive GE of the ability to seek reimbursement for its use by utility customers. The NRC has reviewed GE's proprietary claim and agrees that the information involved is proprietary and should continue to be withheld from disclosure.

This completes NRC's action on your request.
