MEMORANDUM (Official Notice Concerning Pipe Supports)

We take official notice that P. Camp is reported, at pp. 66 and 60

of the Meeting With Tugco and NRC/TRT, October 23, 1984, Bethesda,

Marvland:

Included in that rext [hot functional testing] heat up will be the thermal expansion test of the deficiencies found the last time. The current status is that we fare? . . . in preparation for ambient measurements for the deficient supports found during hot functional testing.

* * *

At the current time, we plan on finishing these incomplete preoperational tests prior to fuel load, in which case they will be reviewed and approved prior to fuel load. Any kind of technical specification deviations that may be associated with thermal expansion, we don't know the scope or extent of those at this time, and we won't know until we finish the re-tests associated with thermal expansion.

If the parties wish to correct these portions of the transcript, they may file corrections within ten days. The matters mentioned appear to be relevant to the adequacy of the design of pipe supports, to the adequacy of quality assurance for design and to Applicants' testimony that there is a safety factor of 40 in the design of this plant.
