SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF MEETING HELD ON FEBRUARY 4, 1985, TO DISCUSS
THE CP&L INTEGRATED SCHEDULING PLAN AND LICENSE AMENDMENT

Background

At a meeting on March 21, 1984 with CP&L, the Brunswick Integrated Scheduling Plan was discussed briefly. CP&L stated that it was pursuing development of the methodology for scheduling and that it would be better able to discuss the methodology and the milestone network in August. This was confirmed in a letter dated March 29, 1984. CP&L presented the methodology for its integrated scheduling program in a meeting with the staff on August 21, 1984. The schedule for formal submittal to the NRC was to submit the license amendment about November 30, 1984 and submit a schedule about February 28, 1985. On November 30, 1984 a draft license amendment, a copy of the Integrated Schedule Program and a draft copy of the Integrated Schedule Plan was submitted. This meeting was held to discuss the November 30, 1984 submittal. The attendees are listed in Attachment 1.

Meeting Summary

The November 30, 1984 submittal by CP&L was discussed in detail. In particular the draft amendment words (Enclosure 2) and the Integrated Schedule Plan (Enclosure 1). Each section was read, discussed and, in some cases, the licensee agreed to make changes. The model used for comparison was amendment No. 75 for the Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station dated July 13, 1984.

When all sections were covered the changes were reviewed. CP&L agreed to resubmit the amendment and the plan in final form. Another meeting will be held on or about February 28, 1985 at which time the revised plan and a draft schedule will be discussed.


