Gentlemen:

This refers to the special safety inspection conducted by Messrs. C. Ramsey, H. Thomas, A. Coppola, J. Ulie and J. Holmes of this office on October 29-31, November 1, 2, 14-16, 26-30, 1984 and January 22-25, 1985, of activities at Fermi Nuclear Power Plant, Unit 2, authorized by NRC Construction Permit No. CPPR-87, and to the discussion of our findings with you and others of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The enclosed copy of our inspection report identifies areas examined during the inspection. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, and interviews with personnel.

Certain of your activities, set forth in the Appendix to this letter, appear to be deviations from commitments which you have made in previous correspondence with the Commission. With respect to item 1 the inspection showed that action had been taken to correct the identified deviation and to prevent recurrence. Consequently, no reply to this deviation is required and we have no further questions regarding this matter at this time.

Regarding the remaining item, a written response is required.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter and the enclosures will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room unless you notify this office, by telephone, within ten days of the date of this letter and submit written application to withhold information contained therein within thirty days of the date of this letter. Such application must be consistent with the requirements of 2.790(b)(1). If we do not hear from you in this regard within the specified periods noted above, a copy of this letter and the enclosure(s) will be placed in the Public Document Room.
