The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment No. 173 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-40 for the Fort Calhoun Station, Unit No. 1. This amendment consists of changes to the Technical Specifications (TS) in response to your application dated August 4, 1995, as supplemented by letter dated January 22, 1996.

The amendment revises the TS requirements for the containment radiation high signal (CRHS) and the safety injection and refueling water (SIRW) tank low signal (STLS) in TS 2.15, Tables 2-3 and 2-4. TS 3.1, Table 3-2, was revised to include administrative changes to the CRHS surveillance methods to be consistent with the applicable surveillance functions. The Basis of TS 2.15 is being revised to clarify that the number of installed channels for CRHS is two. The term "SOURCE CHECK" is being deleted from the definitions section.

A copy of our related Safety Evaluation is also enclosed. The Notice of Issuance will be included in the Commission's next biweekly <u>Federal Register</u> notice.
