Oral argument on the pending appeal of the Citizens Concerned About Nuclear Power, Inc. (CCANP) will be held at 9:30 a.m. on Thursday, December 13, 1984, in the NRC Public Hearing Room, Fifth Floor, East-West Towers Building, 4350 East-West Highway, Bethesda, Maryland.


Appellant CCANP will be allotted a total of one hour for the presentation of argument. It may reserve a portion of its time for rebuttal. The respondents Houston Lighting and Power Company and the NRC staff will be allotted a total of one hour for presentation of argument, to be divided as they see fit. In the absence of agreement, each respondent will be allotted 30 minutes. In preparing for argument, counsel may assume that the Board will be familiar with the Licensing Board's decision that is the subject of the appeal, as well as the appellate positions of the parties as reflected in their briefs.
