Your revised Operations Quality Assurance Plan (OQAP) for the South Texas Project (STP) dated March 28, 1996 has been received for NRC staff review pursuant to 10 CFR 50.54(a). The revised OQAP is intended to present the STP methodology for implementation of graded quality assurance in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR Part 50, Appendix B. Due to the extensive nature of the changes proposed and envisioned interactions between STP representatives and NRC staff reviewers during the review, it is anticipated that the staff effort will require more than 60 days to complete. This letter, in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(a)(3)(iv), constitutes notification to that effect.
