STAFF REQUIREMENTS - BRIEFING/POSSIBLE VOTE ON UCS 2.206 PETITION ON TMI-1 EMERGENCY FEEDWATER, 2:00 P.M., TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 1984, COMMISSIONERS' CONFERENCE ROOM, D.C. OFFICE (OPEN TO PUBLIC ATTENDANCE)

The Commission was briefed by NRC staff on the Director's decision regarding the UCS petition on Three Mile Island (TMI) Unit 1's emergency feedwater system (EFW).

Commissioner Asselstine requested a "rack-up" of the seismic qualification aspects of plants, including TMI-1, that did not have seismically qualified EFW systems at the time of the accident at Three Mile Island Unit 2.

The Commission requested copies of two back-up slides listing hardware modifications to be completed prior to restart and at the time of the first refueling. The Commission requested that staff indicate which modifications are required by NRC as opposed to modifications being undertaken voluntarily by the licensee.

Chairman Palladino requested that Commissioners vote on the requests put forth in the November 2, 1984 letter from the Union of Concerned Scientists and that, subject to that vote, Commissioners vote on whether to take review of the Director's decision.
