Subject: WORKER KILLED IN FALL FROM COOLING TOWER

At approximately 10:05 a.m. (EST) on November 6, 1984, an employee of the Lathrop Corporation fell about 35 feet to his death while working on a new concrete support column in the plant's cooling tower.

Plant emergency personnel rushed to the scene, but the worker, who apparently slipped from a ladder while descending from a scaffolding, apparently died on impact.

The licensee is investigating the accident.

The State of Ohio will be notified.
