Dear Administrative Judges:

In your memorandum of November 8, 1984 you summarized the content of a November 7, 1984 conference call concerning reporting requirements for Consumers Power Company during the shutdown phase of construction. Since that telephone conference the Applicant has sent the Staff a proposed agreement with respect to data that needs to be collected and reported.

The Staff is studying Applicant's proposal. The Board has previously indicated a preference to receive a document on which the Applicant and Staff agreed prior to April 1, 1985.

Although the Staff is pursuing this matter, it is not clear that we will be able to complete our review, confer with the Applicant, and provide a document to the Board on which Applicant and Staff have agreed by April 1, 1985.

I will keep the Board advised of the Staff's progress.
